#### **Hosting YMCA Regional Youth Conference:**

## Hosting YMCA Responsibilities: (Local YMCA and National together)

- Supervise the Local preparations and coordination.
- Provide support and work together with APAY.
- Appoint Youth Conference Coordinator
- Responsible for local coordination and local logistical concerns;
- Conference site, accommodation, Food, Transport, program, resource persons, etc..
- Conference materials and tools (name tags, not book, T-shirts, conference bag etc..)
- Prepare budget estimates of program items and related expenses
- Volunteer / Staff support
- Plan for the workshops theme together with APAY.

#### **APAY Responsibilities**

- Overall supervision/coordination of the youth conference through APAY Executive Secretary and Youth Participation and Leadership Development Committee of APAY.
- Send invitation and correspondence to National movements and related persons
- Follow up movements for participants
- Finalize program contents and related activities/ Projects for the implementation of the program.
- Receive application form and flight schedule of participant
- Coordinate with the host YMCA on update/development of program preparations.
- Settle all the necessary financial obligations.

### **Time Frame**

- Application open from July 2013.
- Deadline for receiving proposals at the APAY office January 2014.
- Presentations by the representative YMCAs to YPLD January to March 2014.
- The Proposal will be discussed at ECM 2014.
- YMCA Regional Conference August 2014.
